I am not sure if this is only in \$read() and not in any other common identifier , also i am not sure if this is only effecting %variables and nothing more related to the parser.			
Example:			
<pre>//write -c testing.txt this is a % \$+ variable test. var %variable = TESTING MESSAGE var -s %r = \$read(testing.txt) echo -a IS: %r</pre>
