

AdiIRC - \$dns - # 3

Added in 1.9.0

\$dns(N)

Returns the IP address that was resolved during a [on DNSevent](#).

See also [/dns](#), [on DNS](#).

Parameters

N - If N = 0, returns number of associated IP addresses, otherwise the Nth IP address.

Properties

.nick - Returns the nick if [/dns](#) was used on a nick.

.addr - Returns the resolved hostname.

.ip - Returns the resolved Ip address.

Example

```
; Lookup a nick
/dns nick
```

```
; Lookup a hostname
/dns google.com
```

```
; Lookup a IP address.
/dns 8.8.8.8
```

```
; Print the results from the lookups.
on *:DNS:{
var %n = $dns(0)
echo 4 Found %n addresses
while (%n > 0) {
echo 4 dns: $dns(%n) nick: $dns(%n).nick addr: $dns(%n).addr ip: $dns(%n).ip
dec %n
}
}
```
