\$error

When an error occurs, the script will jump to :error and continue running, [\\$error](#) will return the error message.

Example

```
alias Example {  
    ; Add a intentional error.  
    noop $hget (  
  
    ; Add a :error label to catch the error.  
    :error  
  
    ; Print the error caught.  
    echo -ag The error is $error  
}
```
