

## AdiIRC - \$fread - # 4

Added in 1.9.0

### **\$fread(name|N)**

Returns the next [\\$crlf](#) delimited line from an open file from the current position.

#### **Parameters**

name|N - Name of the file or the Nth file.

#### **Properties**

.back - Returns the previous [\\$crlf](#) delimited line from an open file from the current position. **(AdiIRC only)**

#### **Example**

```
; Open a file.
/fopen Example Example.txt

; Add some text to the file.
/fwrite Example Hello World

; Read the next line.
//echo -ag Next line is: $fread(Example)

; Close the file.
/fclose Example

; Delete the file.
/remove Example
```

### **\$fread(name|N, M, &binvar)**

Reads M bytes from an open file to a &binvar.

#### **Parameters**

name|N - Name of the file or the Nth file.

M - Number of bytes to read from current position.

&binvar - The &binvar to read into.

#### **Properties**

.back - Returns M bytes from an open file to a &binvar backwards. **(AdiIRC only)**
