

AdiIRC - \$opnick - # 5

Added in 1.9.0

\$opnick

Returns the nick that was (de)opped during a [on OP](#) on [on DEOPevent](#).

Example

```
on *:OP:*:echo -ag The nick opped is $opnick
```

```
on *:DEOP:*:echo -ag The nick deopped is $opnick
```

Added in 2.0

\$opnick(#[,N)

Returns the Nth operator nick.

Parameters

- The channel.

N - If N = 0, number of nicks, otherwise the Nth nick.

Example

```
//echo -ag There is $opnick(#[,0) operator users
```

```
//echo -ag First operator nick is $opnick(#[,1)
```
