Bot Bugs / Issues

The bot is currently able to give info on select identifiers, commands, and events.

If there's a problem with the bot, See '!Adi info' for contact information.

If its pertinent and critical, highlight the bot developer in #adiirc on freenode, under the nick of kspencer/lotaSpencer. If you're on ElectroCode, he's the owner of the channel. (lota/Ken)
