

AdiIRC - On_SOCKCLOSE - # 5

Added in 1.9.0

on <level>:SOCKCLOSE:name:<commands>

Triggers when a connection is closed by the remote connection. (not by [/sockclose](#))

Parameters

<level> - The [User Access Level](#) for the event to trigger.

<name> - The [\\$sockname](#) to listen to.

<commands> - The commands to be performed when the event listener's criteria is met.

Example

```
; Open a connection to AdiIRC.com, port 80.  
/sockopen adiirc adiirc.com 80
```

```
; Make a request for the index page.
```

```
on *:SOCKOPEN:adiirc:{  
    sockwrite -n adiirc GET / HTTP/1.0  
    sockwrite -n adiirc Host: www.adiirc.com  
    sockwrite -n adiirc  
}
```

```
on *:SOCKCLOSE:adiirc:echo -ag adiirc.com closed the connection
```
